Queen Victoria's favorite geranium, it is said, 'Appleblossom Rosebud' has large flowers with clusters of tightly gathered petals, all tipped in rose pink.

Annual; tender perennial; 2 ft tall

Color: White flowers with dark pink edges

Full sun; Soil: Rich, well-drained

Hardiness Zones: 9,10

Hardiness: TA

## Geranium 'Red Rosebud'

Double geraniums were touted as good cut flowers in Victorian times, as the petals held much better than delicate single forms. Red Rosebud has petite clusters of bloom that look like little nosegays in a bright lipstick red.

Annual; tender perennial; 1 ft tall

Color: Red

Full sun; Soil: Rich, well-drained

Hardiness Zones: 9,10

## Geranium 'Velma Cox'

In Victorian times they were called 'Horseshoe Geraniums' after the patterned leaf markings. This variety combines hues of tawny gold, brick red and green, with showy salmon flowers. Picture perfect grown in terracotta pots.

Annual; tender perennial; 1 ft tall

Color: Salmon flowers; tawny gold, brick red and green foliage

Full sun; Soil: Rich, well-drained

Hardiness Zones: 9,10

## Geranium 'Skeleton Rose'

Also called 'Dr. Livingston', this variety has been found to contain almost 100 times as much citronella as the publicized citrosa. Take advantage of its insect repelling properties and place a few pots on the patio. The scent is strong lemony-rose; the flowers are lavender with purple spots.

Annual; tender perennial; 2 ft tall

Color: Lavender with purple spots

Full sun; Soil: Rich, well-drained

Hardiness Zones: 9,10
